### About the position

**The Georgia Department of Public Health** is seeking a **Nutrition Education Program Consultant** for the Maternal and Child Health WIC/Nutrition Unit. This position will be under limited supervision. The incumbent will provide technical assistance and training for the WIC Nutrition Unit. Assist with planning, directing, and implementing various nutrition components of the WIC program statewide. Evaluate programs for compliance with state and/or federal guidelines.

### **Position responsibilities**

• Nutrition Training Coordinator - Serves as the primary point of contact for organizing VENA and other nutrition education conferences as well as maintaining continuing education files.

•Serving as the lead consultant working with the WIC Policy and Program Development Unit; coordinating the Nutrition Unit's areas of responsibility related to annual updates to the WIC Procedures Manual and State Plan.

•Engaging in extensive traveling to the various Georgia local Health Districts to assist with WIC program audits/reviews to ensure federal and state compliance; assisting with the development and dissemination of consultative corrective action follow-up trainings and/or in-services.

•Overseeing ongoing State and District-level WIC nutrition-related surveillance and assuring timely reporting of the State's Nutrition Unit applicable data.

•Reviewing and providing written feedback on district's state nutrition plans and facilitating goal setting among state and district WIC Nutrition programs intended to meet key performance indicators; coordinating the annual updates of state and District nutrition profiles; working with District's Nutrition Service Directors as it relates to building partnerships with regional physician office health personnel and other applicable community partners to ensure optimal communication for positive maternal and child health nutrition-related outcomes.

•More matters Campaign - coordinates annual activities surrounding increased fruit and vegetable intake among the WIC population statewide.

•Coordinates the review and approval process for nutrition education materials statewide

•Coordinates the identification and distribution of nutrition manuals and publications such as ADA Nutrition Care manual.

•Researching and distributing best practices to state, district and local staff; providing translation of nutritional science and related technical information for WIC individuals, health specialists, and population-based dissemination; and assisting with the creation and dissemination of

nutrition information materials to staff, districts, and populations using recognized modes of communication (i.e. email, internet and/or other modern technologies)

•May assist with the supervision of public health nutrition/dietetic interns.

•On an as needed basis, provides technical support around Nutrition Education to district and local agencies as requested in the development, implementation, and improvement of the WIC program.

Chairs the Nutrition Education Committee / Nutrition Education Materials Committee

Bachelor's degree in a related field and five years experience performing work related to area of assignment Or Master's degree in a related field and two years experience performing work related to area of assignment Or One year at the lower level or position equivalent.
